AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING HOME APPLIANCE SERVICE AND REPAIR TECHNICIANS FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PLUMBING CODE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 2 Section 23: Nothing in Chapter 142 of the General Laws, or 248 CMR 10 shall prohibit home appliance service or
- 3 repair technicians from making plumbing connections or disconnections from existing plumbing lines in
- 4 accordance with repairing or replacing said appliances.
